Music for Food's **Artist Fellows Program** helps young professional musicians on the path toward citizen artistry, using their music as a tool for social justice. Fellows serve as ambassadors for Music for Food, presenting assemblies, masterclasses, and concerts at K-12 schools in the Greater Boston area. Fellows meet with local experts and arts administrators to learn about how to be effective advocates and artists. Topics covered include communications and marketing, public speaking, arts management, youth education, and

- Artist Fellows receive a stipend of \$2,000 per semester, travel expense reimbursement of up to \$400, and a \$500 lesson stipend.
- The Artist Fellows program is open to post-graduate students and young professionals.
- Pre-formed duos and trios are encouraged to apply!

Objectives:

Artist Fellows serve as ambassadors for Music for Food and partake in the following activities:

- Attend Music for Food concerts, greet patrons & describe our organization
- Perform on Music for Food concerts, as arranged with Artistic Director
- Create and present school assemblies in the Greater Boston area
- Perform masterclasses and concerts and provide coaching to students at area K-12 schools
- Meet with local experts & arts administrators to learn the skills necessary to be effective advocates and artists, covering such topics as: public speaking, marketing and public relations skills, youth education, civic engagement, arts management, and more.

Stipend:

- Artist Fellows receive a stipend of \$2,000 per semester, travel expense reimbursement of up to \$400, and a \$500 lesson stipend.
